EXHIBIT REQUIREMENTS

Our purpose is to hang an exhibit that best presents and promotes your work, so please adhere to these requirements.

1. Each **Museum Artist** may submit one piece. The work must have been created in the last year.
2. All mediums are acceptable, including assemblages. Sculptors, please contact the exhibits committee regarding space availability.
3. Work may not have been exhibited before at TAM. The Museum reserves the right to screen entries.
4. The Museum sells art off the wall in the Studio Gallery. If we sell a piece, we will contact the artist and ask him/her to bring a replacement piece.
5. Artists may not remove work prior to the end of the exhibit. No exceptions.
6. All work must be original. Reference photos must be the copyright property of the artist.
7. All work must be properly framed or gallery wrapped and wired for hanging. Wet work is not acceptable. No sawtooth hangers are allowed.
8. Maximum vertical size including frame and mat is 30" and maximum horizontal size including frame and mat is 42".
9. Labels (on page 2) must be fully filled out and marked with either a price or NFS. The Museum will retain a 25% commission of the sale price. One label must be attached to the back of each piece (upper left hand corner when facing the back), and the other label must be presented upon check-in on **Friday, January 8 between 11 am and 1 pm and on Saturday, January 9 between 11 am and 1 pm.**
10. The Studio Gallery has limited hanging space. When necessary, the Exhibits Committee reserves the right to limit the number of paintings hung in any exhibit, but will do so fairly, providing each Museum Artist the opportunity to exhibit work during the year.

DELIVERY AND PICK-UP OF ARTWORK

1. **Deliver art to the Museum between 11 am and 1 pm on Friday, January 8 or Saturday, January 9.** If you cannot deliver your work at that time, please make arrangements to have someone deliver for you. **No early deliveries. No exceptions.** Please note that the Museum is closed from January 1 through January 14 but will be open at the designated hours on January 8 and 9 to receive your art.
2. Pick up art between 11 am and 5 pm on **Saturday, March 13. No exceptions.** Art not picked up on this date will be picked up by a Museum Artist representative and stored at his/her home. He/she will not be responsible for any damage to art.

For the Love of Paint will be showing with the *Contemporary Japanese Crafts* exhibit toured by the Japan Foundation. The opening of the exhibits will be on Thursday, January 14 at 7 pm. Gordan Hardcastle will be the featured artist in the Hall Gallery.
