





















LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Change is inevitable

The saying "change is inevitable" rings true even at The Art Museum. After the retirement of Executive Director, Miyai Abe Griggs in July of 2023, we ushered in a whirlwind of change for the 2023 - 2024 season. For the first time in more than a decade, The Board of Directors was tasked with the monumental challenge of vetting, interviewing, and hiring a new Executive Director. For many of us, it was an experience unlike any other, but out of it came the important decision to hire long-time employee Alexa Stanger as the new Executive Director. Having served as the Education Director for 20 years, Alexa knew the history and the mission of the museum. She had a firm grasp on where we've been and an expansive vision of where we need to go. Furthermore, she has a passion for this museum that was not possible to find outside of the establishment. After a full year in the position, I can wholeheartedly say, we made the right decision.

The change in position for Alexa meant bringing on a new Education Director to fill the vacancy. Emily Wunderlich was selected, and in speaking for the board, we couldn't be more pleased. She has brought new energy and new ideas. She is continually pushing to bring enhanced opportunities to established artists, kids of all ages, and community members alike. She is dedicated, ambitious, and committed to the mission at TAM.

The newness of the moment also brought along the need for more staffing changes. Chloe O'Laughlin, (a former board member) was hired as Communications Director. As a Board member, they brought invaluable knowledge about the current marketing, advertising, and social media landscape. They shared ideas about how to reach more people and attract a larger audience. More importantly, they had the experience to bring those ideas to fruition. It was impossible to pass up the opportunity to bring them on as a full-time employee to assist in forwarding the mission of TAM. Jessica Hull Livesay (Business Manager), Jesslyn Low (Education Assistant), and Ryan De Frisco (Visitor Services Coordinator) have been integral partners in the day-today success of TAM. This past year required their support and expertise. They have been patient and helpful in a time of change, continually providing stability and service. Again, in speaking for the board, we are grateful for their contributions to the mission of TAM.

All of these changes simply set the stage for the biggest change of all. After many years of tabling the Education Center expansion, we have set in motion the capital campaign and have a goal to accomplish this project by 2029. The staff and the board, with the help of museum volunteers, community members, and friends, have created a solid plan to expand the building that will serve the growing needs of the community well into the future. Resin Architects have laid the plan to paper with excellent design strategy and a level of expertise that brings comfort and confidence. The City of Idaho Falls has been supportive of this project and knows how impactful this will be to our city and surrounding areas.

As Board President, I am excited to watch these changes continue to unfold and gain speed in the coming year. I am excited to watch our supporters, museum members, and the larger community get involved and embrace the passion that so many of us have for this project. I hope the excitement will help harness the same strength that was necessary to build this beautiful museum 22 years ago so that we can continue to push forth the mission of TAM.

Focusing on grand philosophies and contemplation, *Passages*, pairs strong imagery with antique printer's plates to invoke moody works of art. The exhibition and title refer to the many phases of life that include loss, recovery and instability. The primary means of conveying these ideas is the subdivision of the rectangle and square. It is used to arrange disparate imagery, wood blocks, color, paper and varying paint surfaces. Ultimately the grid serves as a metaphor for the hidden structure of our lives, a fragile, yet vital framework that is revealed when disruptions or traumatic events occur.

ARTWORKS

During the 2023-2024 school year, TAM continued to serve as a vital visual arts resource for over 2,000 students in local schools, community organizations, and families through TAM's education program ARTWorks.

Three free Community Days enlisted museum educators and volunteers to serve more than 1,300 visitors who participated in a hands-on artmaking experience. In addition, TAM provided over 480 visitors and students with guided museum tours with art lessons and seven monthly art visits to preschool students at Head Start. In April, the annual *Young at ART* exhibit and the *Congressional Art Competition* featured the artwork of over 800 Idaho students, grades K-12.

In total, the Artworks program impacted over 3,800 students, family members, and educators.

YOUTH & TEEN CLASSES

During 2023-2024, young people between the ages of 4-18 participated in youth classes and camps. TAM also partnered with the Idaho Falls Public Library to present a lesson on puppetry during their Summer of Creativity program.

In addition to providing the annual ARTrek summer camps for youth between the ages of 5-12, TAM created an additional week of ARTrek summer camps for teens ages 13-15. TAM educators were invited to provide art classes and a fieldtrip for the Idaho District 91 summer classes held at Longfellow Elementary.

During 2024, TAM offered new classes for adults including the TAM Humanities Lecture Series, Beginning Watercolor and Beginning Drawing, Clay Studio sessions, and printmaking workshops.

TAM partnered with the Idaho Falls Public Library and the Creative Aging program to present an eight-week workshop on beginning drawing for participants ages 55 and up.

Beginning in January of 2024, hour-long lectures were provided by regional scholars on a variety of topics and were free for TAM members. Fine arts workshops were provided throughout 2024 by Linda Aman, Diane Hill, Sally Ellis, and Bernadette Regnier, which covered color theory, perspective drawing, printmaking, and painting. Due to high demand, two additional adult clay studio sessions were added to the classes already offered at TAM. Three new Clay Studio instructors gave life and new ideas to the program.

The TAM Education department formed three new partnerships with local organizations throughout 2024 which include The Development Workshop Incorporated (DWI), Life Care Centers, and the Alzheimer's Association.

The Alzheimer's Association met with Executive Director, Alexa Stanger and Education Director, Emily Wunderlich to talk about providing a class for adults with early-onset or full dementia and Alzheimer's disease.


